- The Ann Arbor Hands On Museum is featuring a new video we produced for our ambulance exhibit.
 - In 2010, we began switching from using diesel fuel to gas in our ambulances after Ford stopped making diesel engines for the ambulance market. Now all of our ambulances run on gas. Fortunately, gas engines are less expensive to purchase and to maintain.
- Winter is coming so watch for caution tape on abandoned vehicles. Caution tape means that emergency responders have already checked on the vehicle and you don't need to investigate or call for help.

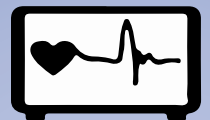
HVA by the Numbers

5 items we take on every scene



Oxygen - to help patients breathe better and reduce anxiety.

LifePak 15 - takes blood pressures, reads heart rhythms and helps restart hearts.



Jump Box - holds breathing tubes, stethoscope, bandages and lots more.

Portable radio - gives medics a way to let the hospital know about the incoming patient.



Drug Box - holds lifesaving medications and other important drugs.
