HVA is a member of Emergent Health Partners, a nonprofit regional provider of mobile health services.



About HVA: HVA provides paramedic ambulance and health transportation services to residents in western Wayne, southwest Oakland and Washtenaw counties.

HVA is a nonprofit, community-owned organization which is governed by a volunteer board of trustees. Founded by five hospitals in 1981, our organization has grown to provide paramedic ambulance service to over one million Michigan residents in eight counties across southeast and south central Michigan, serving 121 local municipalities.

HVA ambulances are deployed out of central support facilities in Ann Arbor and Plymouth, and we have additional ambulance stations in Chelsea, Dexter, Manchester, New Boston, New Hudson, Saline, South Lyon, Van Buren Township and Wixom.

We achieve economies-of-scale through:

- Fluid deployment of ambulances across municipal boundaries.
- Maximum utilization: We assign more ambulances to emergencies during peak 9-1-1 periods while transporting non-emergency patients during slower periods. 90% of our ambulances are ALS, so they can handle both types of calls.
- We are a leader in the development of best practices as Michigan’s largest ambulance operation.
- Group purchasing of vehicles, life support equipment and supplies save dollars.
- Our secondary PSAP provides medical self help instructions to 9-1-1 callers—relieving that burden on municipal dispatching centers.
- We spread our overhead (dispatching, billing, training, administration) over a large call base—over 150,000 calls last year alone

No tax support: Some individual municipalities provide paramedic ambulance service themselves. These require tax subsidies in addition to the ambulance fees received. HVA is a public-private partnership which breaks even without municipal subsidy.

High quality, consistency and reliability: We provide consistent, high quality, compassionate care. We are a leader in EMS research and evidence-based protocol development. We became the first ambulance service in southeast Michigan to be nationally accredited in 1993 (now there are 30 accredited services in Michigan). We began diagnosing heart attacks in the field seventeen years ago in all of our municipalities. We also have a committee of our Board of Trustees devoted to improving Quality.

Huron Valley Ambulance is a consolidated municipal success story; a public-private partnership thanks to the support we receive from each of our 121 municipalities, 22 hospitals, our more than 700 staff members and volunteers, our partners, and the volunteer members of our board of trustees and oversight committees.
